ASIC (Aviation Security Identity Card)	\$220
CASA Exam fees <i>Allow a budget of approximately \$165 for RP theory exam, \$150 for each CPL theory exam (there are 7 exams) and \$160 for the Instrument Rating theory exam.</i> Note: An Invoice for all your exam fees will be issued at the completion of the RPL phase of your training. We will then book and pay for your CASA exams as required.	\$1200 - \$1400

CASA flight test fees (\$750 for RPL, \$850 for CPL and Instrument Rating and \$500 for Multi Engine test)
Landing fees – Air services charges. Approximately \$2200 for Diploma of Aviation (CPL) and an additional \$650 (Approximately) if also conducting the Diploma of Aviation (Instrument Rating).
CASA licence issue fees \$200 - \$300
